



A statement about th§e Humanitarian disaster at the Rokban camp

In the middle of an uninhabitable desert area near the Syrian Jordanian borders, Sixty thousand displaced Syrians are suffering the lack of basic life necessities of food, water, and medicine as they are being suffocated by a blockade imposed by the Syrian regime which is preventing relief caravans from reaching the camp.

the National Syrian party for justice and constitution (WA'ED) considers this a complete war crime as has been stated in the Human rights declaration and international treaties and holds the Syrian regime directly responsible for this humanitarian crises in the camp.

WA'ED party appeals to the international community and human rights organisations to act immediately to focus the world's attention to this humanitarian disaster and to save the suffering families from dying of hunger, draught and disease.
